OWNER COMPLETION PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITIES -MUST MEET ALL LOCAL CODES

CARPENTRY:

- 1. Install plywood where units join in floor, attic and each end.
- 2. Adjust doors if necessary.
- 3. Install insulation between units as needed at cased openings and doors.
- 4. Install cased openings and doors.
- 5. Install door stops as needed. Install screens.
- 6. Sheetrock repair and paint.
- 7. Insulate as required, for example, upper level if cape plan.
- 8. Clean job site and do landscaping.

Most items except the following items are considered carpentry: HVAC, electrical, plumbing, floor covering and providing suitable access to the house site for the crane and all necessary equipment required to set the house. Most materials are included except the HVAC.

PLUMBING:

- 1. Provide and install all material for plumbing as needed, including all waste, vents and service water lines.
- Make all connections, including connecting water lines to water heater, running pipes through floor. (hot, cold and relief lines are provided to stub through floor.) Install water heater if necessary.
- 3. Extend all vents from lower level plumbing through roof as required. This material is provided by Nationwide.
- 4. Provide fittings and connect all vents, drains and water service lines between levels on a stack-on two-story house.
- TIGHTEN ALL THREADED PLUMBING CONNECTIONS THROUGHOUT THE HOUSE PRIOR TO TURNING ON WATER AND TEST SYSTEM FOR LEAKS.
- CAUTION: DO NOT LEAVE WATER TURNED ON UNATTENDED UNTIL SYSTEM HAS BEEN OBSERVED FOR A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS.
- 7. Make all minor repairs, if necessary, such as adjusting stops, traps, faucets on sink, lavatories, tubs and adjusting toilets.
- 8. Provide sewer or septic system if required.

·ELECTRICAL

- Provide and install temporary meter base. Provide and connect service between meter and main panel. Provide and connect ground to main panel, meter and ground rod as per code.
- 2. Make wiring connection between house sections (connectors are labeled).
- 3. Install front and rear outside light fixtures and other fixtures not installed.
- 4. Connect all 3-way switches when run between floors (on basement and cape houses).
- 5. Install box and receptacle for ground fault outlet if not factory installed.
- 6. Make wiring connections to water heater and install cutoff to meet code.
- 7. Provide and install all wiring in basement, garage, or other attachment, if applicable.
- 8. CHECK ALL CIRCUITS AND OUTLETS FOR PROPER VOLTAGE PRIOR TO OCCUPANCY. (Final test all circuits)
- 9. Make all minor repairs, if necessary, such as replacing defective switches, receptacles, etc.
- 10. Provide material and hook up A/C and heating units.
- 11. Wire well pump if applicable.
- 12. Wire and hook up TV and phone jacks (jacks are installed with conduit). Install all light bulbs.

Other Owner Responsibilities:

- 1. Obtain building permits and water supply.
- 2. Complete driveway, walks, decks, porches, garage, gutters, etc.

Owner's Estimated Cost: Building materials are currently increasing. An estimation to complete is now \$60 per sq. ft., but there are many variables that can affect change, up or down. It is recommended that the owner secure quotes from local suppliers and subcontractors.
